- Review of Southern California Wildland Fires and the Hazmat Response. Hazmat
 Teams engaged in supporting USAR operations moved on to hazard mitigation and
 hazard identification markings CERS data mapping of hazards. First deployment of
 hazmat teams to a WUI incident of this size. The discussion also considered the need
 for the HZSO position and the All Risk IMT's. Discussion on the denial of the request for
 additional HM Teams. Chief Jensen discussed the interest more so now of Hazmat
 personnel during these all risk incidents
- Chief Jensen updated the group on the status of NFPA 470 which is currently under rewrite. It will be more condensed but is written in mind for all types of Hazmat responders not just firefighters. Discussion of a Class 10 for Lithium Batteries
- Discussion on the mapping programs and the need.
- We went over the Hazmat Officer/ Safety Officer position paper and we discussed the
 recommendation that this position be placed under Ops not Safety. The current
 discussion is to rewrite the paper with a new working group with a direction on where to
 place this position. We discussed the benefits to Safety and Ops. Marcus discussed the
 conversations with IMT members. Chief Jensen discussed the recommendation for the
 OPS section.
- Kevin presented the HM Coordinator active list and a communication platform for all hazmat coordinators. Kevin will work with Brian Mancebo to develop this app.
- Cody Clem presented a document that will track all of the documents that we may be responsible for and set the review cycles.

- Chief Roberts gave the Firescope update. We have corrected the roster to reflect the relationship to the BOD. Discussion on the IROCC system.
- 3/4/25 Day 2 started at 0900
- Discussion on whether to have a session or just a booth at Continuing Challenge
- Jack Fry Presented the final ICS 208 HM to the group for final review. A discussion on whether this should have its own numbering series all the 208 series. Chief Tobias discussed adding UN#, NFPA 704 and Visible Hazard class to the Section 19 comment section This addition will be added and submitted to the Committee. MOtion to move forward by Chief Freeman and Seconded by Clem
- Dunivin gave an update on the Foam Tender Team Typing. OSD draft should be available by the next meeting. Dunivin gave a review to the new members.
- Chief Rezende gave an update on the Lithium Battery Ad Hoc. Most work will be done tomorrow at the Ad Hoc meeting. The first presentation of the CSTI Lithium Battery response for FRO's course will be presented later this month. A Discussion for the future of alternative fuels. This course may probably be a requirement for FF2 curriculum.
- The MEL updated process started with Clem volunteering to be the MEL Scribe to keep
 a consistent language. Mancebo presented the results of a summary Looked at JHAT
 concepts as part of the requirement the ability to function as a JHAT. The team reviewed
 10 submittals on the survey and had deep discussions on several items including M256
 kits, lithium ion battery equipment were included. We discussed updated layout options
 that were ADA compliant.

 was the White Paper on staffing and the Type 2 upgrade to 8 people. Kern County Oil
