

#### Course Registration - NEW

- The form will be found on the <u>SFT User Portal WebForms</u> Link page.
- The online form contains the same information as the existing PDF but will serve to expedite scheduling and increase accuracy related to properly recording billing information in tandem with the new invoicing feature. This form should be used for all courses that end on or after **July 1, 2024**.

#### Invoicing program - NEW

- New invoice/payment program to be implemented via Acadis July 1, 2024 -Course Invoicing and it is now available on the <u>Course Delivery webpage</u>
- The Registered Instructor will enroll students directly into the course via their own portal and the portal will generate the invoice electronically once the submission has been approved.
- Students will need ID prior to course attendance, "New Student" option will not be available
- In preparation for the new feature, it is recommended that persons responsible
  for paying invoices on behalf of an agency create an SFT ID and portal
  account, then submit a request to be added to an organization's record as an
  approved invoice payor. See the <u>SFT User Portal WebForms</u> Link page to
  access both the SFT ID Request form and the Agency Billing Contact Request
  form.
