April BoD Meeting Report (4/6 & 4/7, 2022) – Johnstone/Gerboth

- Meeting was held in San Diego.
- The OES Director couldn't attend.
- All the documents approved by the Ops Team were approved by the BoD.
- There have been requests to add members to the Board of Directors. One of those requests came from Cal Chiefs. A request to a member from small to medium departments (24 fire stations or less) for both north and south. These were voted on by the BoD, and it was agreed upon overwhelmingly to include members of the groups that were requested. This will go to the Director of OES for final approval.
- The Board decided to table the request from DOI until additional information is provided.
- There was a vendor that did a presentation regarding personnel tracking.
- The BoD discussed the prioritization of OES engines being sent out first when strike teams and prepositions are deployed.
- There was an additional tasking delivered to the BoD regarding civil defense guidelines.
- A request for support in adding an IT Support Unit/Leader (ITSU/ITSL) into ICS that would be lateral to the Communications Unit.

- First printing was for 15,000 FOGs in March. We will need to do a second printing due to heavy demand for the manuals. Looking at a price increase to cover the costs of printing. Currently, the cost to produce the FOG manual is approximately \$15 and we sell it for \$10.
- Originally, we had some issues with paper, so the printing was delayed.
- The app's beta version is currently being tested. Technology has improved since the first app was developed. This app is more user friendly. It's more interactive.
- o It should be out by the end of June or the beginning of July.
- May not have physical copies printed of the FOG in the future.
