USFS/DOI – Goss

- Complex Incident Management transition plans are due back from each Geographic Area Coordination Center on June 15th. The CWCG Ops Committee provided a draft recommendation plan to the CWCG Executive Board this week for them to look at and approve in time to meet the deadline. Six different elements were addressed. Rostering/Mobilization/Recruitment and Retention/Team Rotation/Qualifications and CIM Field Evaluations/Application and Selection Process. This is a nationwide request from the National Multi-agency Coordination Group.
- Work continues on the implementation of the new wildland firefighter series position description job series "0456". Potentially late summer early fall federal agencies will begin asking employees to switch over to the new series. Congress needs to approve the 2024 Presidential Budget in order for the firefighter pay to increase, this will also include portal to portal for federal employees at 50% of their base salary.
