FIRE FIGHTER CERTIFICATION

Fire Academy Instructor Qualifications (per *PM*, Section 6.6) – *DISCUSSION*/PETTY

- Completed and issued January 2024, will occur ever quarter
- SFT system-wide query
 - Fire and Emergency Services Instructor 1 Certified (or equivalent) Completion of Ethics (any version)
 - Possession of Fire Fighter 2 or Tenured Path Certification

IMPORTANT: Certification Exam – Compliance Issues

- Candidates shall be supervised at all times (Staging, breaks, to/from stations).
- Written Exam shall be in an approved location and supervised throughout personal devices are prohibited
- Simulation available ONLY if corresponding FSTEP course complete (FC3, FC4, CPVRT)
 - New Exam Request Form will require course code/information
- Certification Exam Simulation Report: <u>Certification Exam Simulation (azureedge.net)</u>
- Any record of written exam questions is strictly prohibited No photos, written account, etc. Confidentiality is paramount.

IMPORTANT: Certification Exam – FF1B Reminder – ERICKSON/PETTY

- SFT Certification Exam provides candidate with IFSAC <u>and</u> Pro Board Certification for Haz Mat FRA, FRO, Decon, and Product Stabilization.
- CSTI/IAFF provide candidates with <u>only</u> Pro Board Certification. This is important for students seeking employment outside CA as an "IFSAC State" will not accept Pro Board in lieu of IFSAC.
- SFT recommends delivery of FF1B Certification Exam to ensure complete certification for your students/candidates.
- CSTI/IAFF Results, if applicable

Candidates may incur FF1 issuance delay

SFT modules cannot be processed until results are received from IAFF/CSTI

Certification Exam – Retake Candidates – BENNETTS

- **NEW** WebForm: Certification Exam Retake Completion form
- Can be completed by Evaluator or Candidate
- Will streamline FF1 Certification issuance

Responsibility of Academy to verify candidate prerequisites are satisfied

- CSRA, FC3, etc.
- Outside/Alternate Candidates: Verification of training

- A. FOG ICS 420.1 2022 Sales App Update..... Johnson a. New App Beta Test.....Lewis/Johnstone i. There is still time to review and provide recommendations. B. Additional members to subcommittees.....All a. Southern and Northern California Solicitation Letter (standby)......Serrano *i.* New participants encouraged to attend SC meetings, will do conferrals of new members upon anticipated approval of 410-4 update outlining participation and voting. C. FIRESCOPE / NCG.....Brown a. It's important for FIRESCOPE to engage with the national NIMS discussions. b. They are looking for help with the FIFA World Cup coming to USA. i. Funding streams are being discussed and assessed. ii. At this point is mostly an awareness for FIRESCOPE to begin to engage and having AHJ discussions. c. Department of Homeland Security Technology Clearing House i. Agreed to manipulate the architecture to reflect some of the work from Tech Connect done by FIRESCOPE. ii. EIT should get engaged with the clearing house. d. Dashboards i. Awareness dashboards for global view for situational awareness. ii. GIS is currently working on these. iii. Several states are looking to develop these dashboards. iv. Looking to develop multi-disciplinary dashboard to assess resource availability and capability. v. Oregon has a dashboard product that covers all-hazard disciplines. We could use their template for California. e. They're looking for SMEs to help rewrite the position description for INCM, COML, RADO and other Comms positions. We need to ensure our subcommittees are engaged in these rewrites to ensure proper language within our ICS system. f. FEMA is looking to do resource typing. They want FIRESCOPE to get involved. However, the discussions are not getting to the FIRESCOPE level. i. Johnstone – FEMA region 9 sits at the BOD and it's an opportunity to give that clarity to the FEMA representative.
