- **FIRESCOPE FOG Manual and App Update - Johnson**
 - We received the first printing of 15,000 copies of the FOG. They are now available for sale on the FIRESCOPE website for \$10 each. The first day that they were available for sale we had 34 orders!
 - The contractor for the FOG app is working on phase II of III. The app should be available in June.

- FIRESCOPE uses GovDelivery to distribute approved documents. It has been very effective. Currently, there are over 51,000 subscribers. That number jumped from 31,000 in only a couple of months.
