1. John Bryant discussed the meeting of the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) being held January 4-8, 1988, at the Riverside Fire Lab. This was accompanied by a handout with the Agenda for the group's tour on January 6.
2. Mike Scherr discussed the changes taking place in the MACS Conference Room, and thanked CDF and USFS for their involvement and contributions.
3. Mike Scherr passed out copies of the Year End Legislative Summary from OES for the team's information.
4. Mike Scherr handed out, for the Operations Team's information, letters indicating completion and distribution of Finance Section Chief I-460 and Cost Unit Leader I-362 Lesson Plans.
5. Mike Scherr passed out and discussed an update on the FIRESCOPE Computer programs.
6. A draft of Don Perry's Newsletter was given to all present for their review and comment. Don requested comments to him by January 17, 1988.
7. Mike Scherr handed out copies of a draft Implementation Plan by Chief Dick Barrows, OES. Mike requested that it be brought with comments to the joint meeting in Fresno.
8. Mike Scherr handed out minutes of the October 21, 1987, meeting of the Fire and Rescue Service Advisory Committee/FIRESCOPE Board of Directors, and a letter regarding their next meeting. The meeting date will change. The portion of the minutes regarding the Ryland Report was reviewed.

9. Minutes were passed out from the CALFIRMS Meetings of November 12, 1987, and December 12, 1987. Discussion ensued regarding the relationship of the Operations Teams and the Task Force.

**Don Perry moved, Dick Wilson seconded that the Operations Team ratify the name change as follows: "Operations Team" to "Operations Team South", and "CALFIRMS" to "Operations Team North". Motion was carried.**

10. The bulk of the meeting was devoted to work on reviewing and expanding the Five Year Plan from the December 11, 1987, CALFIRMS Meeting. To assist, Mike Scherr passed out minutes of the October 26, 1987, Operations Team Meeting and the November 18-19, 1987, Joint Operations Team-CALFIRMS meeting, as well as the Task Force's Draft Five Year Plan dated November 30, 1987, and an informational item on Communications from the November 30, 1987, issue of Emergency Preparedness News.
11. Concern was expressed regarding training and the State Fire Marshall. Tight performance standards should be set if SFM is to get money for training.
12. Mike Scherr handed out an informational item from CDF about the Prescribed Fire Incident Status Reporting System for Vegetation and Watershed Management. This is an adaptation of the ICS 209 Computer Program for prescribed fire.
