- II. The minutes of the July 20-21, 1989, Joint Operations Teams Meeting in Quincy were approved.
- III. Chief Aronson reported on the September 13, 1989, meeting of the Fire and Rescue Service Advisory Committee/FIRESCOPE Board of Directors. The December meeting had been postponed due to fog in Sacramento. Chief Aronson also reported on the status of the Fire and Rescue Division of OES since his appointment as Chief in November.
- IV. The new Field Operations Guides (FOG) are out. Of the 15,000 copies printed, only 600 are left.
- V. Chief Scherr led a discussion on the Urban Search and Heavy Rescue Specialist Group. The Operations Team North must submit a list of names to Mike Scherr by the next Joint Operations Teams meeting. Chief Beckstrom will coordinate.
