FARSITE (Sue Hasari) program based on several different its and pieces of other programs. Dr. Mark Finney PHD developed this GIS based program. Tool will not work without pre-existing local information layers. Fuels, elevation, aspect, wind (weather), I think the 3 necessary layers are fuels, topography, and weather. I am not sure yet. Marana may host a Train the Trainer course to instruct the FARSITE software, may want to explore OES participation, for example Jeanne Taylor from the Pasadena DFO, the whole process requires a GIS person, a weather forecaster, and a FARSITE person to develop a real time fire behavior projection. Sue requested help from this group (Ops Team) to promote the use of FARSITE. Ops Teams need to support. Data layers are developed though Mapping Specialist Group. Need to have Training Specialist Group to assist in how we can make FARSITE a useful tool. Task Force to brainstorm this issue.

Radio \$30,000 - mounted in one air attack plane now. C-21 fixed wing acquired for use for "line scan", probably not field ready this year. Two layers of clothing this year for firefighters.
