1. I.C.S. Slide/Tape program presented by Bob Irwin. This program is a product of the information contract. It is not in final format; comments were favorable.
2. Philpot discussed reasons for united efforts of FIRESCOPE and Prevention people. A handout was given to members that explains in depth aspects of the Prevention effort and how it can tie into FIRESCOPE.

Concerns expressed about impact on program when we are behind in our work now.

Motion by F. Borden, seconded by Land.

Operations Team recommends PSW Research provide the FIRESCOPE Program an analysis of impacts of including Prevention in the Program. This analysis will not require any substantial help from agencies not already involved.

Motion carried.

3. Strike Team Designators: G. Lund presented a compromise proposal for changing S/T designators.

Motion by Barrows to accept the proposal, seconded by Clark.

Discussion:

The new system is confusing, making a change in "mid season," real impact to get it done at this time, also increases chances for duplication of numbers. Allows for better recordkeeping in finance and other areas, meets OES agencies' needs.

4. Communications Report - Hensley

Handout provided on ICP/Headquarters system. This recommendation is basically a telephone system from the I.C.P. - Agency - OCC and etc., to be used when no commercial system exists.

Philpot motioned to accept committee recommendation - seconded by Barrows, with Item 3a eliminated.

Vote - All approved.

5. Dick Barrows discussed use of frequencies in the FIRESCOPE Program. Other agencies outside the program want to enter into the agreements to share frequencies too; this can be a big problem.

The group discussed the many potential problems, with a consensus that Tom Hensley and the Program Office will do some staff work and make a report at the next meeting. Items such as legal issues, operational needs, etc., will be covered.

6. Training - Barrows

We need to understand some of the problems Ed Bent has with such things as limited funds, no way to supply training materials, and no funds for instructors. About all Ed can do is coordinate our efforts in training. Dick was concerned that State fire problems and capabilities were not fully understood by FIRESCOPE members. He recommended we get clarification from Ed on May 22, 1980.
