Old Business:

- Respiratory Protection Document: (Pisciotta)
 - Conducted one final review, now ready to be forwarded to Task Force for their review
- TEMS draft
 - Jason Shelton(LFD) (TEMS SME) is the FIRESCOPE representative regarding TEMS

New Business:

- **Flagging:** The flagging color Standardization project came to us from the Task Force

- **Action Item:** Proposal to generate a Flagging Guidance document that is consistent with current available references that shows current recommendations (Morrill/Walsh).
- **ICS-701 Emergency Response to Tactical Law Enforcement Incidents:** it is now located under the Safety Specialist Group download documents
- **Action Item: Develop a White Paper of “Best Practices for Safety in the Fire Services”**(Walsh/Parker/Ferro)
 - Due to Task Force by May 17, 2016 for recommendations
 - Due to Ops Team by June 2016
 - Ops Team is looking for a list of items that should be addressed in the reporting system
 - Ops Team also looking for a game plan to develop a FIREScope Template for developing a Serious Accident Review Team (SART) report. SSG agrees to provide a list of items for departments to consider when going to activate a SART
 - Ops Team looking for recommendations from the SSG of how to best obtain, store and distribute the SART information so that it is absorbed (not just made available) to the end user
 - **Action Item:** Develop a Template for SART reports(Walsh/Parker/Ferro)
 - CalFire, Feds, and many departments already have templates
 - Ops Team is looking for either a choice between those or a merge of the best of each template or a recommendation to make them all available
- **ICS-215A forms and Risk Management Assessment Process:**
 - **Action Item:** SSG would like to have both Forest Service and CalFire versions of the ICS-215A forms posted on FIREScope website, awaiting updated versions to forward to Task Force for posting (Witt)
- **Rapid Extraction Module Support (REMS) ICS-223-12**
 - **Action Item:** Develop white paper on REMS to address minimum training, qualifications, recommendations and possible typing (Reyes)

Group Business:

- Reviewed and updated Plan of Work, Charter and Rosters (Confidential and non-confidential)
- Reviewed Presentation for California Wildland Fire Risk Management Summit
- Group discussion on displeasure from SSG that the FIREScope website is not reflecting our fliers, minutes, and agendas in a timely manner, and missing archived minutes from 2008. Also that the current format of the website is not intuitive.
