10. Meet with Bill Mauger and reviewed the latest draft of the Gen. Fam. slide tape training program. Return consolidate Task Force comments on Strike Team Leader slide-tape course.
11. Reviewed element #3 of the information contract "Incident Command System" directed towards a management level audience.
12. Dick Barrows has requested the Task Force consider further modification of the strike team designator system. He would like multi-agency strike teams to have an agency identifier that would not identify any one agency, i.e.;
