Items Discussed:

- 0830 - Worked on draft #4 of O.C.C./SITSTAT reporting procedures - made several minor changes. When revised, it will be ready to be presented to the Operations Team on May 1 & 2. Terry is preparing the cover memo.
- 1100 - Discussed distribution of new C.R.T. terminals to be purchased this year. Some re-alignment was made from last meeting.
- 1130 - Started working on command team exercises.

- 1300 - Continued struggling with command team exercises. We came to the conclusion that it is a near impossible task for the following reasons:
1. Lack of agency personnel to support the exercises.
 2. Conflicting task force availabilities.
 3. In order to accommodate the 14 teams requested in a two week period, objectives had to be diluted.
 4. Most agencies can be more effective by providing these exercises internally with task force support - This can be done more easily this year than on a multi-agency basis. It was decided not to attempt multi-agency command team training this year.
