- 2. Communications:

Copies of a Department of Commerce Newsletter was passed out. It described a \$100,000.00 effort in 9 areas. Chuck Mills will report to the Task Force on this project on 5/26.

3. "Procedures For Full I.C.S. Incident in The Core Area During 1977"

Task Force reviewed SDC document as instructed by OP's Team and made the following changes:

- (4 Al. (2nd Sentence) SDC drafted a sentence to cover MULTIJURISDICTIONAL Fires.
- (4 A3. Change Item 3 moved up to sentence "Orders Not Filled...

 Add in front of OCC "The appropriate agency at the OCC facility".

Eliminate - Sentence "Resource Orders..."

4. Discussed Sitstat Manning/Operations Requirements.

It was agreed that CDF and USFS would provide Mode 2 Manning. Augumentation would be required from partners during Mode 3 & 4. It was agreed that we need a Mode 3 & 4 commitment from partners other than CDF & USFS for augumented Sitstat Manning.

5. Review of SDC Document "Analysis of the Operation's Coordination Situation Status Unit for the 1976 Fire Season".

Task Force reviewed the "Yellow Pages" of the above report. Recommentations were as follows:

- A. B. I. A. Job description referred to needs to be approve.
 - B. OES/OCC Coordinator is the alternate if he is available. His alternate is the CDF or USFS ECC Chief.
- 2. Manning: Concern was expressed on augumentated manpower from the agency having the incident. No agreement was reached by the Task Force.

C. 2. Radios:

Should monitor channels in Sitstat used for initial attack. Should look for alternatives to the CDF Region VI intercom.

- 3. Should point out that a total of two terminals are needed as documented in the text of the report.
- D. 2. Should include "core area" support items and should exclude day-to-day engine numbers showing instead a total number until an agency is committed, then show amount of commitment.

Status Board in Command Conference Room should show "On Duty or Inservice" rather than "available".

- 3. L. A. County Fire Dept. may not have a need for the "Firecast", they will evaluate.
- 4. Validations should be done by Task Force Members.
- E. Region VI CDF Intercom is Overloaded.

- G. We recommend moving the Command Conference Room to the new addition.
