C. Creasey led a discussion on the present status of the GHQ/MACS Matrix project that he is working on with H. McElwee. Project to be completed and presented to the June OPS Team Meeting. Committee to present their draft to Task Force at the May meeting.

A copy of the Addendum update was distributed to members. A discussion followed to prepare Chairman for OPS Team Meeting.

K. Hammond read a letter from M. Barrows directed to the OPS Team in reference to the Resource Ordering Program. M. Barrows is handling this assignment on behalf of OPS Team in coordination with M. Scherr.

A discussion was held regarding the draft letter to be sent along with the ICS Proposed Changes to the OPS Team. D. Castleman moved to accept the draft letter with the recommended changes. This will be put on the June OPS Team agenda.

A discussion on the ICS Proposed Change that deals with Air Operations was tabled until more information is available from M. Barrows.

C. Creasey has been asked to attend the OPS Team April 25 meeting to present a report on the Hazardous Materials Specialist Group.

C. Creasey gave a report on the last Hazardous Materials Meeting. The group is working on first responder information. They are to come up with an outline or some guidelines as to what is necessary for first response to a HazMat incident. The Hazardous Materials Group will have this information in final form at the April 30 meeting to be held at Camp 2.

C. Anderson reported on the recent PIO Specialist Group Meeting. The newsletter deadline was January 1, 1985. The Task Force is directing the PIO Specialist Group to send back to the Task Force for evaluation a "rough draft" of a newsletter.

K. Hammond and M. Barrows will be getting together with M. Harris to discuss the direction of this group.

K. Boyd gave a report on the Weather Specialist Group Meeting. He covered the proposed Maintenance Program, based on BLM's Maintenance Program, for Remote Automatic Weather Stations. Also discussed was the RAWS Computer Program. It is anticipated this research will soon be completed. At that time the Task Force would like a final presentation. The next Weather Specialist Meeting will be held on May 22, 1000 hours in Riverside.

ADP Specialist Group - No meeting.

J. Linder has become the OES representative on the HazMat Specialist Group, Training, Weather and Liaison as well as representative to the Mapping Group. He is also an alternate to the Communication and PIO Group.

The next Mapping Specialist Group Meeting will be held at Camp 2 on May 9. There will be a report for the next Task Force Meeting.

D. Castleman gave a report on the Training Specialist Group Meeting.

K. Hammond suggests that the 6-month activity reports for the specialist groups be delivered at a joint meeting consisting of Task Force and all specialist group chairmen.

The annual review of 410-2 MACS Procedures will be discussed at the next Task Force Meeting.

A discussion was held regarding the positions of the Task Force Chairman as it relates to being a liaison to specialist groups. It was generally felt that the outgoing chairman would assume the job of liaison to the incoming chairman's specialist groups.
