1. Agreed to cancel second day (Dec 19) due to the lack of participation. SBC, VNC, and CDF not represented. No need to work on MACS development unless all agencies are represented.
2. Chairman for next 6 months was discussed. SBC will take the chairmanship and Barrows to attend next Operations Team meeting with new chairman.
3. Approved ADP Plan of Work as presented by the Program Office. Recommend it go to the Operations Team for their review and approval.

Cook told the Task Force that the Program Office is bringing on another computer person to work on the ordering process. The general feeling of the Task Force is that the timing is not right to bring on another person until the Task Force does more work on MACS development. Task Force recommends this goes to Operations Team before Program Office takes action.

4. Haney handed out the first of his working sheets (draft) of discussion on MACS development by the Task Force. Terry will document the Task Force's actions as MACS is developed.
5. Agreed to go ahead with the new revised Form 209. No changes from last meeting. Creel to work with computer people and Haney to do art work on Form.
6. Scherr informed the Task Force that Roger Land was putting up a computer program to keep track of I.C. Advisors and their qualification by agency. Agencies input needed by January 10, 1981.
7. Reviewed Task Force Program of Work.

Next Task Force Meeting is scheduled for January 7 & 8 1981, USFS Riverside CA Forest Fire Lab.
