1. The Mapping Groups symbology proposal was approved by the Task Force and the Program Office (Arnie Masoner) was advised of its acceptance.
2. A draft of the Strike Team Leader slide tape training course was reviewed with the contractor.
  - ..More emphasis is needed on the S & R section.
  - ..Need to identify supervisor responsibilities when out of service.
  - ..Better explanation of how to obtain service and satisfy needs when out of service.
3. Task Force was advised that due to present work commitments the Communication Work Group is unable to develop communication vehicle specification. Accepted the offer of CDF to use their ECC personnel (Refino & McClure) to research communication vehicle requirement and needs, and to make recommendation for review of Task Force and Communications Work Group.
4. Eight more synthesized mobile radios (120 channel) should be delivered in approximately sixty days. Distribution recommended by Communications Group is:

5. A rule of thumb for the Communications Group to use in development of incident communication system is:
  - ICP should be completely operable within two hours of request to activate and twelve phone line capability is a goal to achieve.
6. There will be a meeting at the Fire Lab March 3rd, to begin development of ICS Finance Section. Attendees will include M. Barrows, M. Harris, A. Masoner, T. Haney and other CDF and USFS "finance experts".
