1. Mike Scherr's new office telephone number is 714/781-3236.
2. Herb McElwee, from Santa Barbara Co. Fire Department, will take over as Task Force Chairman on January 15, 1981. Claude Creasey, from Los Angeles City Fire Department will be co-chairman.
3. Task Force discussed ICS and MACS problems we had this past fire season. Identified problems within the function of ICS and MACS operation. Agreed that there is a need for some type of multi-agency training within the FIRESCOPE region. Task Force will review their findings with the training group chairman before presenting it to operation team for action. (Options to meet 1981 training needs attached.)
4. Had a discussion with program office people and computer people on what times are involved in computer programming, etc., and what the computer peoples' time is being spent on. Some Task Force members had a concern with what programs were being worked on and how much time it takes to put up a program. This discussion was six(6) months late. Agreed there has to be better communication between Task Force and computer people. Computer people should present an update to Task Force periodically.
5. Priority of work for Task Force was agreed to; they are:
 1. 1981 training need
 2. 1981 MACS procedures
 3. S&R Section position description update
 4. MACS development

The above tasks are identified in the Task Force program of work.

6. Computer people gave a presentation on what the new RESTAT program would look like.


Program looked good. Task Force made the following input.

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1. Add Res/Med Units under resources
2. Add order number
3. Realign Resource column to add Res/Med and be same as Form 209
4. Have the ability to tie incidents together.

Will take up to six(6) months to get program up and running.

7. Form 209 given to computer people with one modification. Eliminate #28, Assisting Agencies, which is already covered in Resource column. Agreed to the 209's instructions as presented by Terry, except for the first page(cover) which will have to wait until the 1981 MACS procedures are written.
