FIRESCOPE
TASK FORCE MEETING

January 11, 1980

1. The Task Force and Bob Irwin met with the Orange County Fire Chiefs Association's Training Committee representatives (Rod Farley, Marcia Fleet and Jim Jones) regarding differences between the Orange County ICS and the FIRESCOPE ICS. The Orange County representatives stressed that their system was adapted from the FIRESCOPE system and was intended to be compatible. They expressed the desire to identify areas where difference could create problems and a willingness to modify their systems to eliminate problems where possible. Time was taken to identify problems and discuss methods of correcting those problems. The Orange County System is presently undergoing revisions and efforts will be taken to incorporate changes necessary to eliminate differences between the two systems. Prior to reprinting, the FIRESCOPE Task Force will be provided a revised copy of the Orange County ICS for review and comment.

The Orange County Fire Chiefs Association has indicated a desire to be more involved in the FIRESCOPE Program. Bob Irwin invited them to participate in the FIRESCOPE Training Specialist Groups activities. The possibility of additional participation will be considered by the FIRESCOPE Board of Directors.

2. Irwin discussed the 1980 Program budget and how matching fund figures were arrived at for the partner agencies.
3. Discussed with Irwin, ways to improve communications between the Task Force and the Program Office.
4. Identified items to be covered in the Task Force report to the Operations Team at January 17th and 18th meeting.
