Will use ICS Forms (standardized). Branching: question of jurisdictional, need firm example. Law enforcement looking at resource typing.

CFWCG Fire Weather Group

In the past this group preferred to stay under CWCG instead of functioning under the FIRESCOPE umbrella. In the past CWCG has not had working/specialist groups under their organization. At the last CWCG meeting, the overall program management will be under CWCG but product development will come to FIRESCOPE. This will work because most of the CWCG members are also FIRESCOPE members. In the future this group will be the FIRESCOPE Weather Specialist Group.
