There are some differences between the NIIMS and ICS and some Task Force members believe we (ICS) should adopt what is in the NIIMS.

 - D. Request from USFS South Zone Air Unit to program their aerial photography missions in the computer. The request was denied because of the workload of the computer people at this time. John to notify the air unit of this action and tell them to fill out the file storage request with more detail.
