- A. Chief Blacker, Rincon Del Diablo, is interested in a FIRESCOPE, ICS seminar. He wants to put it on himself for the North San Diego County area. Land has recommended to Blacker that it may be beneficial to have the FIRESCOPE Task Force give assistance or the seminar in total. Land will contact Blacker and get more information on dates, time, number of people, documents needed, course content, etc. The Task Force will assist in the seminar.
- B. Irwin - Senate subcommittee meets tomorrow on the 2.4 million budget for FIRESCOPE 1979-80. House has passed the 2.4 million budget.
- A redirection of priorities from the Board of Directors is to shelve the current work on ICS, MACS decision making process and focus on the major incident fire analysis of the siege of fires from September 11-21. This work is to be headed by T. Haney, Task Force, Agencies.
- Chuck Mills' replacement, Richard Kimberling from USFS Region 6, should report to Southern California approximately November.

- D. Agency identifiers for the remainder of the State of California are needed. Task Force would like to see if the winter crews of the OCC (South Zone, RO VI, OES) will work on this.

- Masoner - A. October 16, Columbro will give presentation on communication work recommendations to be presented to the Ops Team and Board of Directors.
- B. October 16, Masoner will present "Frequency Utilization Agreement" for final review before Ops Team presentation.
- C. IR vehicle van box has been awarded to a firm in San ^{FRANSISCO} ~~Bernardino~~.
- D. Check with Program Office for past ICS evaluations. Pinecrest ICS evaluation is at the Program Office and will be given to the Task Force.
- E. Any agency that took pictures on any of the September fires that ties into the ICS, contact Masoner at the Program Office.
- F. Telephone systems for Comm 3 and Comstat 6 are still in process. Mitel representatives will be here Friday September 28 to look at vehicles. Masoner will coordinate with Montclair and L. A. County and get back to Task Force.
- G. Handouts on program of work and contract modifications for SDC were passed out.
- H. "Prime" was awarded contract for computer system - can deliver by December 1.
- Haney - A. Major incident fire analysis to encompass OCC, incident, agency dispatch, agency command level. Summaries from these four areas to include problems, etc. Program to alter contracts and work programs to accomplish this assignment so as to have viable recommendations, changes, etc. in these areas. Final product to be presented to Ops Team and Board of Directors as soon as possible.

MACS design should benefit from this document in its development.

Recommendation on how to accomplish this task is to develop questionnaire to these three areas with Task Force and work group support for review. Questionnaire should be directed to the responsible persons from responsible agency - may include cover letter from responsible B.O.D. Consolidation of these reviews (Task Force and contractor) should be channeled to the Board of Directors through the decision process. Recommendations from this analysis need Board of Directors direction for program of work and who is to do what.

Target date for analysis recommendations in draft is:

Finalize questionnaire October 2; mailed out week of October 8 with return by October 19.

Review groups to start review process week of October 23.
